



The National Association of Emergency Medical Technicians (NAEMT) is honored to assist U.S. and NATO military training centers in conducting TCCC courses for their personnel.



NAEMT provides a full complement of support and quality assurance services for TCCC training:

- All TCCC courses conducted through NAEMT use the latest guidelines and curricula prepared by DHA-JTS with no deviations to ensure standardized, high-quality training.
- TCCC courses offered through NAEMT are:
 - approved for continuing education credit by the Committee on Accreditation for Prehospital Continuing Education (CAPCE) for all published TCCC tiers;
 - recognized by the National Registry of EMTs (NREMT);
 - approved for nursing continuing education credits by the Emergency Nurses Association (ENA); and
 - endorsed by the American College of Surgeons Committee on Trauma.
- NAEMT secures continuing education credit through CAPCE and ENA for new or updated versions of TCCC courses.
- Students who successfully complete a TCCC course through NAEMT receive a certificate of completion, a TCCC card good for 3 years, and continuing education credit (the number of CE credits varies by tier).
- NAEMT submits eligible student records to CAPCE for continuing education credit.
- NAEMT assigns an experienced military TCCC Affiliate Faculty member to conduct a site visit of the training facilities using a standardized evaluation tool to verify that the training center meets minimum requirements.
- TCCC courses offered through NAEMT are taught by qualified instructors who have met standardized instructor requirements.
- NAEMT maintains a database of all approved TCCC instructors and notifies instructors of all curriculum updates provided by DHA-JTS.
- NAEMT maintains a registry of students who have successfully completed a TCCC course.
- NAEMT provides a secure, user-friendly online Education Portal through which all course administration is conducted, including course registration, assignment of approved faculty, student and instructor roster management, and payment.
- The Education Portal includes a feature to provide broad access



and oversight to Service branches to monitor all TCCC courses, faculty and student activity.

- NAEMT has trained staff to assist training center administrators and instructors.
- NAEMT maintains a customer service center that is available by phone or email to support training centers, faculty, and students.
- Additional quality assurance measures include regular, independent course evaluations of students and faculty that are reviewed and analyzed, and appropriate follow-up action is taken, as needed.

NAEMT offers these services in a low-cost package.

- There is no fee to establish a new training center.
- U.S. and NATO military training centers pay an administrative fee by course (based on the number of students in the course. \$5/student for Tier 1 (ASM), and \$10/student for all other tiers.
