Peter T. Pons, MD, is an emergency physician in Denver and has been actively involved with pre-hospital care and disaster preparedness for more than 30 years.

He has worked as the Associate Director for Emergency Medicine at Denver Health Medical Center (formerly Denver General Hospital) and as Professor in the Division of Emergency Medicine in the Department of Surgery at the University of Colorado Health Sciences Center.

Pons has served as the EMS Medical Director for the 9-1-1 paramedic ambulance service in Denver, based at Denver Health, as well as for several fire-based EMS systems. He has published numerous peer-reviewed journal articles on EMS and edited several textbooks for emergency medical technicians and paramedics. He has served as the physician director for numerous mass gatherings and special events in Denver, including the Denver Grand Prix, World Youth Day and the visit of Pope John Paul II.

He has lectured nationally and internationally on EMS and served as a member and chair of the EMS Committee for the American College of Emergency Physicians.
