

Metro Transportation Directions to/from Capitol Hill

How to obtain a Metro Pass:

Single fare cards are no longer available, so you must purchase a SmarTrip Card or use SmarTrip on your smartphone (available for iPhone with Apple Wallet or Android with Google Wallet).

- To purchase a SmarTrip Card:
 - You can purchase a SmarTrip Card at the metro station at the fare vending machine, located before the turnstiles, with cash, credit, or debit. The cost to purchase a card is \$10, which includes \$8 in stored fare value.
 - You can add fare value to your card at the station. We recommend a minimum of \$10 in stored fare value on your Smart Trip Card to ensure you have enough to cover the roundtrip fare.
 - SmarTrip Cards have no expiration date.
- To use SmarTrip on your phone:

Instructions from Crystal Gateway Marriott to Crystal City Metro Station (about a 5-minute walk):

- Walk south on S. Eads Street to 18th Street
- Turn left onto 18th Street and cross Richmond Highway
- Head down Metro stairs to Crystal City Metro Station

Instructions from Crystal City Metro Station to Capitol Hill:

- Direct Line – Blue Line (about 32 minutes, up to 45 minutes in low peak)
 - Board Blue Line toward Downtown Largo
 - Exit at Capitol South Metro Station
- Indirect Line (includes transfer) – Yellow Line to Orange, Blue, or Silver Line (about 20 minutes, up to 45 minutes in low peak)
 - Board Yellow Line toward Mount Vernon Square
 - Transfer at L'Enfant Plaza Metro Station and board Orange Line toward New Carrollton, or Blue or Silver Line toward Downtown Largo (located on lower level down the escalators)
 - Exit at Capitol South Metro Station onto First Street, SE

Capitol South Metro Station to Congressional Offices/Capitol:

- Exit at First Street, SE
- Travel north on First Street, SE
- On your immediate left are the House Office Buildings – Cannon, Longworth, and Rayburn
- Directly in front of you is the U.S. Capitol
- For Senate Office Buildings – Dirksen, Russell, and Hart – travel north on First Street, SE, toward and then past the Capitol; about a 12-minute walk

Capitol Hill to Crystal Gateway Marriott:

- Direct Line – Blue Line (about 32 minutes/up to 45 minutes in low peak)
 - Board Blue Line toward Franconia-Springfield
 - Exit at Crystal City Metro Station
- Indirect Line (includes transfer) – Orange, Blue, or Silver Line to Yellow Line (about 20 minutes/up to 45 minutes in low peak)
 - Board Orange Line toward Vienna Fairfax-GMU, Blue Line toward Franconia-Springfield, or Silver Line toward Ashburn
 - Transfer at L'Enfant Plaza Metro Station to Yellow Line toward Huntington (located on upper level up the escalators)
 - Exit at Crystal City Metro Station

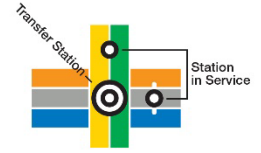
